### Note:

The label "Regal 236" (on frame verso) indicates the painting's specific location in the storage facilities of the Wiesbaden Central Collecting Point in the immediate post-war period.

The traditional attribution to Jan van Huysum could not be substantiated. The painting is not included in the catalogue raisonné by Maurice Harold Grant.

The present work was instead found to bear stylistic similarities to still lifes by Justus van Huysum, such as the one now in the Staatliche Museum in Schwerin (inv. no. 429). These similarities are particularly evident in respect to the treatment of foliage.
